Dear Parents,

Students, who are able to meet the requirements for the 8th grade class trip, will be traveling to Eureka, MO, on Thursday, May 16th to visit Six Flags. The students will have the opportunity to socialize, enjoy the park's numerous thrill rides, and also learn about how Math & Science play an integral part in the creation of these rides through a provided curriculum from Six Flags. **If your student meets the requirements, they will need to bring \$25 to the school to pay for his/her ticket to Six Flags. They should pay this \$25 to their homeroom teacher by Tuesday, May 14th. Please be aware that there will be absolutely no refund of the price of admission in case of bad weather. The rides will remain open as long as there is no lightning present, just FYI. Please feel free to contact me if there are any questions about the weather/refund policy.**

In order to keep the cost to you as minimal as possible, a school lunch will be provided for your student. It will consist of a turkey sub, chips, baby carrots, apple slices, cookie, and a drink. Six Flags does not allow outside food to be brought inside the park so the plan is to have the students eat their lunch in the parking lot before entering the park for the day at approximately 10:00 a.m. (Six Flags does not open until 10:30 a.m.) As a result, I am allowing students to bring additional money to purchase items inside the park if they want. Students will also be allowed to carry their cell phones as well. With their safety in mind, I would request that any student, who is planning on carrying their phone, please provide their contact number to Rhonda Dawson or Polly Reichle before the trip. We will be the only people who will have access to this information and only will use it in case of an emergency. This is completely voluntary and is up to the discretion of parents/guardians. Even though students will not be able to access the Water Park, I would still recommend a change of clothes in case they choose to ride water rides and do not wish to remain soaking wet all day.

Please remind your student that the same dress code will be enforced on the trip that is normally enforced at school. Students dressed inappropriately will be asked to change or call home if necessary. Six Flags has recommended that all students wear tennis shoes, if possible, while inside the park. **Please be aware that neither District #27, nor its employees, is responsible for any lost or stolen items on this trip, however.**

7:15 a.m.	Depart for Six Flags (charter buses from Vandalia Bus Lines, Inc.)
9:45 a.m.	Arrive at Six Flags in Eureka, MO.
10:00 a.m.	Lunch in parking lot at Six Flags
10:30 a.m.	Enter Six Flags for the day
4:30 p.m.	Depart from Six Flags for Lincoln
6:45 p.m.	Arrive in Lincoln
