
About Me







Anxiety: Take a deep breath. Have a friend consult a teacher and ask if they can take you to the hall if possible. Hopefully the teacher would understand and let you. This can be a serious situation and may effect the rest of your day. Make sure you talk to the person in short, choppy sentences, stay calm around them, and make sure they don't do anything bad.

Choice Making: Stop to think. Will this choice matter in 5 days? 5 weeks? 5 months? 5 years? Access the situation: take the choices and imagine yourself in them. Which makes you happier?

Low Self-Esteem: Repeat after me: I am perfect. I am pretty. I am 100% pure and I love myself. Repeat that a few times a day and you should be okay. I tried doing this myself, and honestly it really helped me. Yes, I do have my ups and downs, but it helped


