THE HISTORY OF ST. PATRICK'S DAY

St. Patrick's day, also know as "The Feast of St. Patrick," was made and official Christian feast day in the early 17th century. It is held on March 17th. This holiday was made to celebrate the heritage and culture of the Irish General, St. Patrick. As for the celebration, people typically wear green clothing and shamrocks. They have parades and festivals open to the public where they lift the restrictions on eating and drinking alcohol for the day. Many Christians also attend church services. St. Patrick's day is now celebrated in more countries around the world than any other national festival. The celebrations we have today are greatly influenced by the Irish Diaspora. St. Patrick's Day is a day in the Christian season of Lent. Lent is where Christians give up something representing the time Jesus spent out in the wilderness while enduring the temptation of Satan and getting ready to begin his ministry. Lent lasts 40, without counting Sundays, days between Ash Wednesday and Holy Sunday. Christians do not count the Sundays in the 40 days of Lent because Sundays are mini-Easters, so they are to be joyful anticipation of the Resurrection. Today, St. Patrick's Day in Ireland is mainly for tourism and showcasing, but in the past, it was such a serious celebration for Ireland that the government mandated that all pubs be shut down for the holiday.





Most people look at him and think, "Oh... he is dumb," or, "Oh... that kid can't even hear what we're saying. He is disabled." Just because that is the image people make for people with disabilities does not mean they are true.

The boy, Jason, refers to everyone else as neurotypicals. Jason knows that the neurotypicals expect something from him that everyone else does. For example, when someone asks you a question, you answer. However, Jason won't respond if he has nothing to say because there is no point. He knows that neurotypicals do a lot of things that there is no point in actually doing. People with autism pay attention to the world around them unlike neurotypicals. They stand there and understand the world in a way that we would never be able to.

When Jason meets a new girl, Pheonixbird (Rebecca), on his website where he writes and reads stories, he realizes that he finally found someone to connect with. Jason found someone who knows him for him, not the image people make of him from his autism.

He is amazing with technology and even writes his own stories. Writing is a way for him to escape the negatives going on in his own life, and he is actually great at writing. 

The MeToo Movement The MeToo Movement

The MeToo Movement was founded in 2006 by Tarana Burke. She created this movement or campaign to help those women who were getting sexually harassed or assaulted. Those who eventually spoke out were called, "Silence Breakers" by the TIME Magazine. After all this had happened and people finally spoke out, Tarana Burke got the Person of the Year award. The person who gets the Person of the Year award is one who has been the most noticed in the news. "For too long, survivors of sexual assault and harassment have been in the shadows. We have been afraid to speak up and say 'Me Too' and seek accountability. For many, the consequences of doing so have been devastating," stated Burke. Approximately, 17,700,000 women have reported being sexually assaulted since 1998.

The reports have helped prove that normally those who are non white and from a low wealth community are the ones reporting the most about sexual assault. Although there is a lot of good in this movement, there has been a lot of backlash. Wendy Williams's negative talk about the MeToo Movement is what is being discussed the most. She says that this movement is 10 years too late and does not do one thing for sexual assault victims. Williams said the movement is not to be productive against sexual assaults.. She disagrees with Robert Sylvester Kelly, better known as R. Kelly, being linked to the MeToo act now. She thinks that him being accused of sexual assault 10 years ago means nothing now because he should have been accountable at that time. "The MeToo act is not going to work," protested Williams. She says that this act/ movement has not done anything for our country or sexual assault/ harassment.




