# HISTORY OF THANKSGIVING

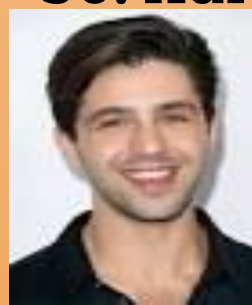
