

History of Halloween

Halloween started 2000 years ago, at a Celtic festival called the Samhain festival. The Celts would wear costumes and light bonfires to ward off ghosts. In the eighth century a man named Pope Gregory III made November 1 to honor Saints. Eventually, it incorporated some Samhain traditions. The night before Saints Day was called Hallows Eve, and later known as Halloween. Overtime, Halloween evolved and people started trick-or-treating, carving pumpkins, having gatherings, eating treats, and having costumes.




