Things You Can Do While It's Cold Outside


- Write a capsule letter to yourself!

Thanksgiving Pumpkin



Pie Recipe

Steps-

- 1. Preheat oven to 425
 degrees F. Whisk
 pumpkin, sweetened
 condensed milk, eggs,
 spices and salt in medium
 bowl until smooth. Pour
 into crust. Bake 15
 minutes.
- 2. Reduce oven temperature to 350 degrees F and continue baking 35 to 40 minutes or until knife inserted 1 inch from crust comes out clean. Cool. Garnish as desired. Store leftovers covered in refrigerator.

- 1 can of pumpkin
- 1 (14 ounce) can
 Sweetened
 Condensed Milk
- 2 Large eggs
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- ½ teaspoon ground ginger
- ½ teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1 (9 inch) unbaked pie crust

I enjoy being different from most people, diabetes is a part of my life. I am still able to do everything that everyone else can do, I just have to be more careful.
