

#### IAR Test Taking Strategies

## These are strategies that can help you take your IAR test this March.

1. Chunking Strategy:

- a. Read a few of your questions on your passage. Afterwards, read to a stopping point you find in the reading. Turn back to your questions and answer them accordingly. Now, repeat the process until the questions are all answered.
- 2. Prove-It Strategy
  - a. Sometimes questions on the IAR tests have multiple answers that you may think are correct. When this happens, start the Prove It Strategy. With your answer choices in mind, go back and reread the passage. As you read, highlight the answer and proof to find the correct answer.
- 3. Personal Knowledge Strategy
  - a. Use your prior vocabulary knowledge to help you answer difficult questions.

#### IAR Test Taking Strategies

#### 1. Return Strategy

a. When taking these tests, there is a bookmark option. If there is a question that you aren't sure about, bookmark it. At the end of your test, return to the bookmarked questions and answer.

#### 2. Discriminator Strategy

a. There are four possible answers for the questions on your test. One choice is obviously not correct. Another answer is relevant but doesn't answer the question. The last two are the correct answer and the weaker incorrect answer. Use the Prove It Strategy to find the correct one.

#### 3. Use It Writing Strategy

a. When you start to write your essay for the IAR test, follow this rubric.Introduction: Attention getter, Background, Thesis; Body paragraphs = 3 Topic sentence that restates the thesis/ prompt, specific evidence from the text, discussion of the evidence that proves the thesis, and conclusion sentence that restates thesis. Conclusion: Restate thesis in a different way, summary of evidence, and strong, final statement

The Death Penalty

Did you know that a University of Minnesota study showed that only 2.5% of victim's families find closure in watching their assailant die? The death penalty is a form of punishment for awful criminals with methods varying from lethal injection to death by fire. Using the death penalty as a form of punishment for heinous crimes has been a very controversial topic for many years. Many people are strongly against or for the death penalty being used. I do not believe that the death penalty is a suitable punishment for any felony.

The death penalty, also known as capital punishment, is an unfair consequence with easy alternatives. **Obviously, there are many changes we as a society need to make the world a less morbid place; therefore, I believe the death penalty should be abolished.** Capital punishment is a very inhuman way to handle criminals in society. A life sentence in prison without parole is a great

example of an alternative. A life sentence without parole would mean that the criminal would live out the rest of their lives in a prison cell. In an article I read called "The Pros and Cons of the Death Penalty", it states that being sentenced to life allows the prisoners to feel guilty and look back at what they did. Prison can make them change themselves into more of a normal citizen than a criminal. Life sentences also completely eliminate the chance of executing an innocent person. According to another article I have read "Pro/Con: Should We Keep the Death Penalty?", a study done by the Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences showed that at least 4.1% of all criminals sentenced to death in the US were actually innocent. The justice system is bound to make mistakes, and using life in prison will make those mistakes less fatal. In conclusion, the world should stop treating fire with fire and abolish capital punishment.

Death rows prisoners are mostly made up of colored and disadvantaged people; therefore, I argue capital punishment is a cruel act that needs to be taken away. The article "Pro/Con: Should We Keep the Death Penalty?" states, "because socioeconomically disadvantaged people cannot afford top lawyers, they receive subpar legal representation and therefore also overrepresented on death row." If a homeless person is taken to court for wrongdoing, they are more likely to be sentenced to death than

a socially wealthy person. If wealth and prosperity decide whether someone should be sentenced to death or not, capital punishment should be abandoned. Some people might say that without the death penalty, families would have to live knowing that the person who killed their loved one was still out there; however, this does not make sense because the person would have been put into prison for the rest of their lives. Prison is a place for criminals to feel overwhelming guilt, which could cause a family more closure than knowing someone died because their loved one did. In conclusion, the death penalty needs to be made illegal because of the discrimination within the justice system and it bringing no closure to families.

I believe the death penalty should be completely taken away from all places in the world, and this is because the money it costs to put someone to death could go to something more worthwhile. In an article I read, it stated, "The legal process can take decades, causing the death penalty to cost at least 18 times as much as a sentence to life without parole would cost." Money that taxpayers are spending should go to a more constructive and positive cause. Would you like to figure out that your tax money went to killing another human? Furthermore, children and the future of society should be where more money goes. A death penalty case costs an average of \$2.4 million. Instead of wasting millions of dollars on killing a human being, we should build better education, healthcare, and overall a better

society as a whole. All in all, capital punishment is an overexpensive consequence that wastes money for no reason.

After looking at all of this information, it is clear that capital punishment should be left in the past with other unhelpful ideaologies. - 2. 2 TBSP cream cheese frosting, soft
- 3. 8 oz candy melts, green
- 4. 10 count 6 inch cookie sticks
- 5. 10 gold coins
- 6. 3 TBSP white sprinkles

- 1. In a large bowl, crumble your cake.
- 2. Add in your cream cheese frosting.Mix well with a hand mixer, spoon, or stand mixer.
- 3. Divide your cake into 10 sections. With the palm of your hand, round out each portion into a ball shape.
- 4. Place your cake pops on a sheet pan or plate, and place them in the freezer for 15 minutes.
- While your cake pops are in the freezer, place all of your candy melts in a medium-sized bowl or coffee mug. Microwave for 30 second intervals until completely melted.
- 6. Remove the cake pops from the freezer.
- 7. Place your cookie stick in the candy melt, then the cake pop. Then add your cake pop to the candy melts. Coat the pop completely with the melt. On the side of the bowl, tap it gently with the stick removing any excess chocolate from the cake pop to create a smooth finish.
