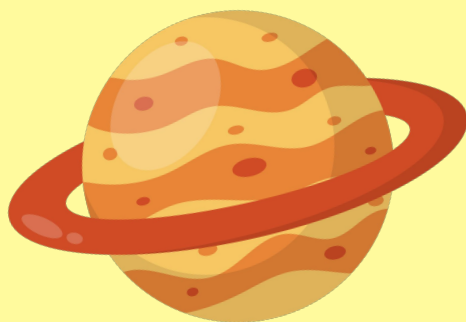


# April Celestial Event

On **April 19th, 2023**, there will be a hybrid solar eclipse.

A **hybrid solar eclipse** is a planetary event in which the **moon passes directly between the sun and the earth**. When this happens, the eclipse casts a shadow across a particular region of Earth for a limited period of time. Hybrid solar eclipses are the **rarest type** of eclipse.

As for when this will occur, the eclipse will **start** on the previous said date (**April 19**) at **9:36 PM** (eastern daylight time) and **end** on **April 20th** at **2:59 AM** (eastern daylight time). Since we are in the **central daylight time zone**, the start and end time(s) would be **8:36 PM on April 19th** and **1:59 AM on April 20th**. Don't miss it! The next one won't be for another decade! **!!! P.S. Just because it's late in the day does NOT mean you can safely view it without solar glasses. Be cautious! !!!**
