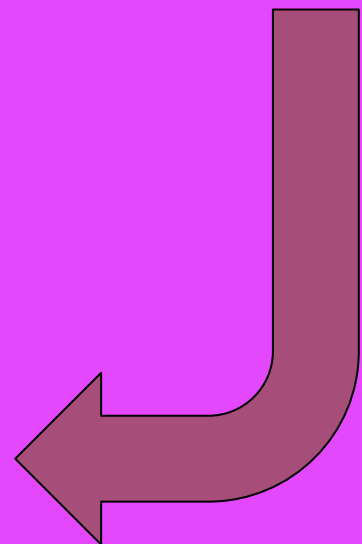

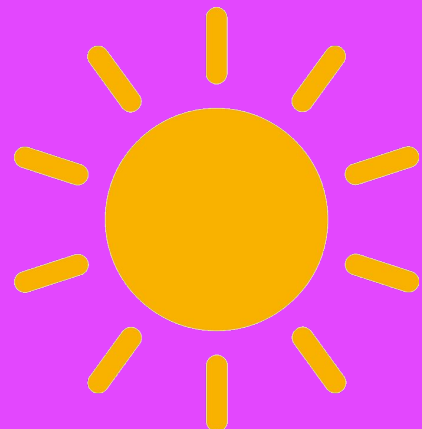

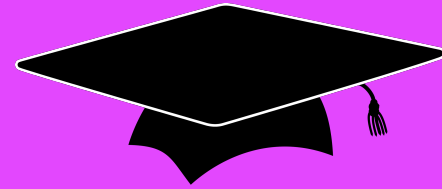
Congratulations
